REGISTRATIONS OF BIRTHS, DEATHS AND MARRIAGES, OCTOBER, 1932.

The Dominion Bureau of Statistics issues today the number of registrations of births, deaths and marriages during the month of October, 1932, in 54 cities of Canada. Stillbirths are registered both as births and deaths.

Births registered in these cities in October numbered 6,706, deaths 3,541 and marriages 2,736 as compared with 7,054 births, 3,688 deaths and 2,859 marriages in October of last year, showing a decrease of 5 percent in births, 4 percent in deaths and 4 percent in marriages.

Births registered in the same cities during the ten months, January-October, of this year totalled 67,941, deaths 37,781 and marriages 23,547 as against 72,477 births, 37,995 deaths and 25,459 marriages during the corresponding period last year. This comparison shows a decrease of  $6\frac{1}{2}$  percent in births,  $\frac{1}{2}$  percent in deaths and  $7\frac{1}{2}$  percent in marriages.

# REGISTRATION OF VESSELS, MARINE AND AIRCRAFT

The Director of the Bureau of the Census has received from the Department of the Interior, Bureau of Land Management, a report of the number of vessels, marine and aircraft, registered in the United States, for the year 1934. The report shows that the number of vessels registered in the United States for the year 1934 was 1,000,000, compared with 900,000 in 1933. The number of marine vessels registered in the United States for the year 1934 was 100,000, compared with 90,000 in 1933. The number of aircraft registered in the United States for the year 1934 was 10,000, compared with 8,000 in 1933.
