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REGISTRATIONS OF BIRTHS, DEATHS AND MARRIAGES, NOVEMBER, 1932.

The Dominion Bureau of Statistics issues today the number of registrations of births, deaths and marriages during the month of November, 1932, in 54 cities of Canada. Stillbirths are registered both as births and deaths.

Births registered in November numbered 6,112, deaths 3,575 and marriages 2,403, as compared with 6,622 births, 3,566 deaths and 2,566 marriages in November of last year, showing a decrease of $7\frac{1}{2}$ percent in the number of births, practically no change in deaths and a decline of 6 percent in the number of marriages.

During the eleven months January-November of this year, births registered in the same cities totalled 74,053, deaths 41,356 and marriages 25,950, as against 79,099 births, 41,561 deaths and 28,025 marriages during the corresponding period last year. This comparison shows decreases of $6\frac{1}{2}$ percent in births, $\frac{1}{2}$ percent in deaths and $7\frac{1}{2}$ percent in marriages.
