PEGISTRATION OF BIRTHS, DEATHS AND MARRIAGES, FEBRUARY, 1932.


The Dominion Bureau of Statistics issues today the number of registrations of births, deaths and marriages during the month of February, 1932, in 54 cities of Canada. Stillbirths are registered both as births and deaths.

Births registered in these cities, in lebruary numbered 6,780, deaths 3,872 and marriages 1,790, as compared with 6,516 births,4,128 deaths and 2,039 marriages in February of last year, showing an increase of 4 per cent in births and decreases of 6 and 12 per cent in deaths and marriages respectively.

Births registered during the two months January and February of this year totalled 13,608, deaths 7,882 and marriages 3,668, as against 13,640 births, 8,196 deaths and 4,042 marriages. The reduction in births was very slight, but in deaths it amounted to 4 per cent and in marriages to 9 per cent.
