REGISTRATION OF BIRTHS, DEATHS AND MARRIAGES, MARCH, 1932.


The Dominion Bureau of Statistics issues today the number of registrations of births, deaths and marriages during the month of March, 1932, in 54 cities of Canada. Stillbirths are registered both as births and deaths.

Births registered in these cities in March numbered 7,010, deaths 4,607 and marriages 1,696, as compared with 7,436 births, 4,168 deaths and 1,566 marriages in March of last year, showing a decrease of 6 percent in births and increases of 11 and 8 percent in deaths and marriages respectively.

Births registered during the three months, January - March of this year totalled 20,618, deaths 12,489 and marriages 5,364 as against 21,076 births, 12,364 deaths and 5,608 marriages. This comparison shows a decline of 2 percent in births and 4 percent in marriages and an increase of 1 percent in deaths.
