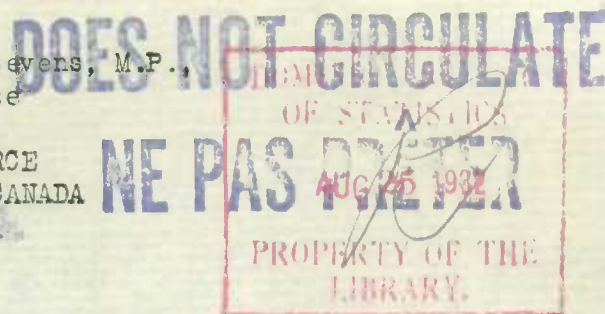

REGISTRATIONS OF BIRTHS, DEATHS AND MARRIAGES, JULY, 1932.

The Dominion Bureau of Statistics issues today the number of registrations of births, deaths and marriages during the month of July, 1932, in 54 cities of Canada. Stillbirths are registered both as births and deaths.

Births registered in these cities in July numbered 6,916, deaths 3,254 and marriages 2,783 as compared with 7,384 births, 3,627 deaths and 2,730 marriages in July of last year, showing a reduction of $6\frac{1}{2}$ per cent in births and of $10\frac{1}{2}$ per cent in deaths, and an increase of two per cent in marriages.

Births registered in these cities during the seven months January - July of this year totalled 47,626, deaths 27,381 and marriages 15,479 as against 50,891 births, 27,048 deaths and 16,553 marriages during the corresponding period last year. This comparison shows a decline of $6\frac{1}{2}$ per cent in births, an increase of one per cent in deaths and a reduction of $6\frac{1}{2}$ per cent in marriages.
