REGISTRATIONS OF BIRTHS, DEATHS AND MARRIAGES, OCTOBER 1933.

The Dominion Bureau of Statistics issues today the number of registrations of births, deaths and marriages during the month of October, 1933, in 70 cities and towns of Canada having 10,000 population and over.

Births registered in October numbered 6,492, deaths 3,832 and marriages 2,991 as compared with 7,242 births, 3,727 deaths and 2,865 marriages in October last year, showing a decline of  $10\frac{1}{2}$  per cent in births, and increases of 3 per cent in deaths and  $4\frac{1}{2}$  per cent in marriages.

During the ten months January - October of this year, births registered in the same cities and towns totalled 67,799, deaths 38,397 and marriages 24,569 as against 72,683 births, 39,611 deaths and 24,604 marriages during the corresponding period last year. This comparison shows decreases of  $6\frac{1}{2}$  per cent in births and 3 per cent in deaths, while the percentage change in the number of marriages was negligible.
