> REGISTRATIONS OF BIRTHS, DEATHS AND MARRIAGES a 71

The Dominion Bureau of Statistics issues today the number of registrations of births, deaths and marriages during the month of November, 1934 in 70 cities and towns of Canada having 10,000 population and over.

Births registered in these cities in November numbered 6,281, deaths 3,630 and marriages 2,838 as compared with 6,125 births, 3,795 deaths and 2,648 marriages in November last year, showing an increase of $2\frac{1}{3}$ percent in births, a decrease of $4\frac{1}{3}$ per cent in deaths and an increase of 7 per cent in marriages.

Births registered during the 11 months January - November of this year totalled 73,067, deaths 41,600 and marriages 30,488 against 73,924 births, 42,192 deaths and 27,217 marriages during the corresponding period last year. This comparison shows decreases of 1 per cent in births and $1\frac{1}{2}$ per cent in deaths and an increase of 12 per cent in marriages.
