REGISTRATIONS OF BIRTHS, DEATHS AND MARRIAGES, MAY, 1934.

The Dominion Bureau of Statistics issues today the number of registrations of births, deaths and marriages during the month of May, 1934, in 68 cities and towns of Canada having 10,000 population and over.

Births registered in these cities in May numbered 6,629, deaths 4,270 and marriages 2,407, as compared with 7,309 births, 4,079 deaths and 2,230 marriages in May last year, showing a decrease of  $9\frac{1}{2}$  per cent in births, and increases of  $4\frac{1}{2}$  per cent in deaths and 8 per cent in marriages.

Births registered during the five months January - May of this year totalled 33,150, deaths 20,197 and marriages 10,383 as against 34,588 births, 20,194 deaths and 9,741 marriages during the corresponding period last year. This comparison shows a decline of 4 per cent in births, practically no change in deaths and an increase of 62 per cent in the number of marriages.
