REGISTRATIONS OF BIRTHS, DEATHS AND MARRIAGES,

The Dominion Bureau of Statistics issues today the number of registrations of births, deaths and marriages during the month of July, 1934 in 70 cities and towns of Canada having 10,000 population and over.

Births registered in these cities in July numbered 6,686, deaths 3,333 and marriages 3,134 as compared with 6,924, births, 3,488 deaths and 2,796 marriages in July last year, showing decreases of 32 per cent in births and 42 per cent in deaths and an increase of 12 per cent in marriages.

Births registered during the seven months January - July of this year totalled 46,685, deaths 27,193 and marriages 17,584 as against 48,266 births, 27,466 deaths and 15,783 marriages during the corresponding period last year. This comparison shows decreases of 32 per cent in births and 1 per cent in deaths and an increase of 112 per cent in marriages.
