REGISTRATIONS OF BIRTHS, DEATHS AND MARRIAGES, DECEMBER, 1935

The Dominion Bureau of Statistics issues today the number of registrations of births, deaths and marriages during the month of December 1935 in 67 cities and towns of Canada having populations of 10,000 and over.

Births registered in these cities and towns in December numbered 6,246, deaths 4,321 and marriages 2,775 as compared with 6,439 births, 3,828 deaths and 2,740 marriages in December last year, showing a decline of 3 per cent in births and increases of 13 per cent and 1 per cent in deaths and marriages respectively.

During the year 1935 births registered in the same cities and towns totalled 79,900, deaths 48,117 and marriages 35,097 as against 79,506 births, 45,432 deaths and 33,261 marriages in 1934. This comparison shows increases of $\frac{1}{3}$ per cent in births, 6 per cent in deaths and $5\frac{1}{3}$ per cent in marriages.
