REGISTRATIONS OF BIRTHS, DEATHS AND MARRIAGES, MARCH, 1935.

The Dominion Bureau of Statistics issues today the number of registrations of births, deaths and marriages during the month of March 1935 in 70 cities and towns of Canada having populations of 10,000 and over.

Births registered in these cities and towns in March numbered 6,755, deaths 4,309 and marriages 1,910 as against 6,855 births, 4,298 deaths and 1,658 marriages in March last year, showing a decline of 12 per cent in births, practically no change in deaths and an increase of 15 per cent in marriages.

Births registered during the three months January - March of this year totalled 19,414, deaths 12,805 and marriages 5,815 against 19,610 births, 11,966 deaths and 5,614 marriages during the corresponding three months of last year. This comparison shows a decline of 1 per cent in births, an increase of 7 per cent in deaths and an increase of 3½ per cent in marriages.
