

REGISTRATIONS OF BIRTHS, DEATHS AND MARRIAGES, AUGUST, 1936.

The Dominion Bureau of Statistics issues today the number of registrations of births, deaths and marriages during the month of August, 1936, in 67 cities and towns of Canada having 10,000 population and over.

Births registered in these cities and towns in August numbered 6,947, deaths 3,596 and marriages 3,472, as compared with 6,888 births, 3,496 deaths and 3,209 marriages in August, 1935, showing increases of 1 per cent in births, 3 per cent in deaths and 8 per cent in marriages.

Births registered during the eight months, January-August, of this year totalled 54,238, deaths 34,910 and marriages 22,792, as against 54,201 births, 32,517 deaths and 21,702 marriages during the corresponding eight months of last year. This comparison shows practically no change in births, and increases of 7½ per cent in deaths and 5 per cent in marriages.
