

REGISTRATIONS OF BIRTHS, DEATHS AND MARRIAGES, JANUARY, 1937.

The Dominion Bureau of Statistics issues today the number of registrations of births, deaths and marriages during the month of January, 1937 in 67 cities and towns of Canada having 10,000 population and over.

Births registered in these cities and towns in January numbered 6,304, deaths 4,678 and marriages 2,216 as compared with 6,625 births, 4,485 deaths and 2,025 marriages in January last year, showing a decrease of 5 per cent in births, and increases of 4 per cent and 9½ per cent in deaths and marriages respectively.
