REGISTRATIONS OF BIR HS, DEATHS AND MARRIAGES, OCTOBER, 1937

The Dominion Bureau of Statistics issues today the number of registrations of births, deaths and marriages during the month of October, 1937, in 67 cities and towns of Canada having 10,000 population and over.

Births registered in these cities and towns during October numbered 6,907, deaths 4,314 and marriages 4,245 as compared with 6,517 births, 4,131 deaths and 3,974 marriages in October of last year, showing increases of 6 per cent in births, 42 per cent in deaths and 7 per cent in marriages.

Births registered in the same cities and towns during the ten months January-October of this year totalled 68,044, deaths 44,877 and marriages 33,796 as against 67,379 births, 42,936 deaths and 31,342 marriages during the corresponding ten months of last year. This comparison shows increases of one per cent in births, 42 per cent in deaths and 8 per cent in marriages.
