REGISTRATIONS OF BIRTHS, DEATHS AND MARRIAGES, NOVEMBER, 1931.

The Dominion Bureau of Statistics issues today the number of registrations of births, deaths and marriages during the month of November, 1937, in 67 cities and towns of Canada having 10,000 population and over.

Births registered in these cities and towns during November numbered 6,316, deaths 4,057 and marriages 3,396 as compared with 5,990 births, 4,124 deaths and 3,093 marriages in November of last year, showing increases of $5\frac{1}{2}$ per cent in births and 10 per cent in marriages and a decrease of $1\frac{1}{2}$ per cent in deaths.

Births registered in the same cities and towns during the eleven months January-November of this year totalled 74,360, deaths 48,934 and marriages 37,192 as against 73,369 births, 47,060 deaths and 34,474 marriages during the corresponding eleven month of last year. This comparison shows increases of $1\frac{1}{2}$ per cent in births, 4 per cent in deaths and 8 per cent in marriages.
