REGISTRATIONS OF BIRTHS, DEATHS AND MARRIAGES. DECEMBER, 1937

The Dominion Bureau of Statistics issues today the number of registrations of births, deaths and marriages during the month of December, 1937, in 67 cities and towns of Canada having 10,000 population and over.

Births registered in these cities and towns during December numbered 6,847. deaths 4,661 and marriages 3,147 as compared with 5,306 births, 4,323 deaths and 2,797 marriages in December, 1936, showing increases of $8\frac{1}{4}$ per cent in births, 8 per cent in deaths and $12\frac{1}{2}$ per cent in marriages.

During the whole year 1937 births registered in the same cities and towns totalled 81,207, deaths 53,595 and marriages 40,339 as against 79,675 births, 51,383 deaths and 36,954 marriages in 1936. This comparison shows increases of 2 per cent in births, 4 per cent in deaths and 9 per cent in marriages.
