## REGISTRATIONS OF BIRTHS, DEATHS AND MARRIAGES,

The Dominion Bureau of Statistics issues today the number of registrations of births, deaths and marriages during the month of February, 1937, in 67 cities and towns of Canada having 10,000 population and over.

Births registered in these cities and towns in February numbered 5,896, deaths 5,179 and marriages 2,025 as compared with 6,372 births, 4,422 deaths and 2,234 marriages in February last year, showing decreases of 4 per cent in births and 6 per cent in marriages and an increase of 21 per cent in deaths, when adjustment has been made for the number of days in the month.

Births registered during the two months January - February of this year totalled 12,200, deaths 9,857 and marriages 4,241, as against 12,997 births, 8,907 deaths and 4,283 marriages during the corresponding two months last year. This compartson shows a decrease of 42 per cent in births and increases of 13 per cent in deaths, and 1 per cent in marriages.
