## REGISTRATIONS OF BIRTHS, DEATHS AND MARRIAGES, APRIL 937

The Dominion Bureau of Statistics issues today the number of registrations of births, deaths and marriages during the month of April, 1937, in 67 cities and towns of Canada having 10,000 population and over.

Births registered in these cities and sowns during April numbered 6,899, deaths 4,582 and marriages 2,626, as compared with 6,634 births, 4,564 deaths and 2,519 marriages in April of last year, showing an increase of 4 per cent in births, one-half per cent in deaths and  $4\frac{1}{2}$  per cent in marriages.

Births registered during the four months January-April of this year totalled 26,233, deaths 19,649 and marriages 9,082 as against 26,803 births, 18,177 deaths and 8,665 marriages during the corresponding four months of last year. This comparison shows a decrease of 2 per cent in births and increases of 8 per cent in deaths and 5 per cent in marriages respectively.
