The Dominion Bureau of Statistics issues today the number of registrations of births, deaths and marriages during the month of July, 1937, in 67 cities and towns of Canada having 10,000 population and over.

Births registered in these cities and towns during July numbered 7,180, deaths 4,002 and marriages 4,077 as compared with 7,001 births, 4,624 deaths and 3,512 marriages in July last year, showing increases of  $2\frac{1}{2}$  per cent in births and 16 per cent in marriages and a decrease of  $1\frac{3}{2}$  per cent in deaths.

Births registered during the seven months January - July of this year totalled 47,430, deaths 32,481 and marriages 20,850, as against 47,291 births, 31,314 deaths and 19,463 marriages during the corresponding seven months of last year. This comparison shows practically no change in births and increases of 4 per cent in deaths and 7 per cent in marriages respectively.
