REGISTRATIONS OF BIRTHS, DEATHS AND MARRIAGES, AUGUST, 1937.

The Dominion Bureau of Statistics issues today the number of registrations of births, deaths and marriages during the month of August, 1937, in 67 cities and towns of Canada having 10,000 population and over.

Births registered in these cities and towns during August numbered 6,796, deaths 4,021 and marriages 3,916 as compared with 6,947 births, 3,596 deaths and 3,519 marriages in August last year showing a decline of 2 per cent in births and increases of 12 per cent and 11 per cent in deaths and marriages respectively.

Births registered in the same cities and towns during the eight months January-August of this year totalled 54,226, deaths 36,502 and marriages 24,787, as against 54,238 births, 34,910 deaths and 23,029 marriages during the corresponding eight months of last year. This comparison shows practically no change in births, and increases of 42 per cent and 72 per cent in deaths and marriages respectively.
