REGISTRATIONS OF BIRTHS, DEATHS AND MARRIAGES, NOVEMBER, 1938.

The Dominion Bureau of Statistics issues today the number of registrations of births, deaths and marriages during the month of November, 1938, in 67 cities and towns of Canada having 10,000 population and over.

Births registered in these cities and towns during November numbered 6,895, deaths 4,328 and marriages 3,419, as compared with 6,316 births, 4,057 deaths, and 3,396 marriages in November of last year, showing increases of 9 per cent in births, 7 per cent in deaths and 1 per cent in marriages.

Births registered during the eleven months, January - November, of this year totalled 77,345, deaths 47,050, and marriages 38,075, as against 74,360 births, 48,934 deaths and 37,192 marriages during the corresponding eleven months of last year. This comparison shows increases of 4 per cent in births and  $2\frac{1}{3}$  per cent in marriages and a decrease of 4 per cent in deaths.
