REGISTRATIONS OF BIRTHS, DEATHS AND MARRIAGES, APRIL, 1938.

The Dominion Bureau of Statistics issues today the number of registrations of births, deaths and marriages during the month of April, 1938, in 67 cities and towns of Canada having 10,000 population and over.

Births registered in these cities and towns during April numbered 6,813, deaths 4,606 and marriages 2,933 as compared with 6,899 births, 4,582 deaths and 2,626 marriages in April of last year, showing a decrease of one per cent in births, practically no change in deaths and an increase of $11\frac{1}{2}$ per cent in marriages.

Births registered during the four months January - April of this year totalled 27,341, deaths 18,181 and marriages 9,646 as against 26,233 births, 19,649 deaths and 9,082 marriages during the corresponding four months of last year. This comparison shows increases of 4 per cent in births and 6 per cent in marriages and a decrease of 72 per cent in deaths.
