REGISTRATIONS OF BIRTHS, DEATHS AND MARRIAGES, MY, 1938.

The Dominion Bureau of Statistics issues today the number of registrations of births, deaths and marriages during the month of May, 1938, in 67 cities and towns of Canada having 10,000 population and over.

Births registered in these cities and towns during May numbered 7,023, deaths 4,595 and marriages, 3,213, as compared with 7,218 births, 4,320 deaths and 3,133 marriages in May of last year, showing a decrease of 3 per cent in births and increases of $6\frac{1}{2}$ per cent in deaths and $2\frac{1}{2}$ per cent in marriages.

Births registered during the five months January-May of this year totalled 34,364, deaths 22,776 and marriages 12,859 as against 32,904 births, 23,905 deaths and 12,160 marriages during the corresponding five months of last year. This comparison shows increases of $4\frac{1}{2}$ per cent in births and 6 per cent in marriages and a decrease of 5 per cent in deaths.
