REGISTRATIONS OF BIRTHS, DEATHS AND MARRIAGES, JUNE, 19382

The Dominion Bureau of Statistics issues today the number of registrations of births, deaths and marriages during the month of June, 1938, in 67 cities and towns of Canada having 10,000 population and over.

Births registered in these cities and towns during June numbered 7,227, deaths 4,122 and marriages 5,089 as compared with 7,218 births, 4,510 deaths and 4,521 marriages in June of last year, showing practically no change in births, a decrease of 82 per cent in deaths and an increase of 122 per cent in marriages.

Births registered during the six months January-June of this year totalled 41,591, deaths 26,898 and marriages 17,948 as against 40,250 births, 28,479 deaths and 16,736 marriages during the corresponding six months of last year. This comparison shows increases of 3 per cent in births and 7 per cent in marriages and a decrease of 5½ per cent in deaths.
