REGISTRATIONS OF BIRTHS, DEATHS AND MARRIAGES, JULY, 1938.

The Dominion Bureau of Statistics issues today the number of registrations of births, deaths and marriages during the month of July, 1938, in 67 cities and towns of Canada having 10,000 population and over.

Births registered in these cities and towns during July numbered 7,283, deaths 3,872 and marriages 3,686, as compared with 7,180 births, 4,002 deaths and 4,098 marriages in July last year, showing an increase of $1\frac{1}{2}$ per cent in births and decreases of 3 per cent and 10 per cent in deaths and marriages respectively.

Births registered during the seven months January - July of this year totalled 48,874, deaths 30,770 and marriages 21,634, as against 47,430 births, 32,481 deaths and 20,871 marriages during the corresponding seven months of last year. This comparison shows increases of 3 and $3\frac{1}{2}$ per cent in births and marriages respectively, and a decrease of $5\frac{1}{2}$ per cent in deaths.
