REGISTRATIONS OF BIRTHS, DEATHS AND MARRIAGES, SEPTEMBER, 1938.

The Dominion Bureau of Statistics issues today the number of registrations of births, deaths and marriages during the month of September, 1938, in 67 cities and towns of Canada having 10,000 population and over.

Births registered in these cities and towns during September numbered 7,284, deaths 4,036 and marriages 4,751, as compared with 6,911 births, 4,061 deaths and 4,803 marriages in September of last year, showing an increase of 5½ per cent in births, and decreases of one-half per cent in deaths and one per cent in marriages.

Births registered during the nine months January-September of this year totalled 63,631, deaths 38,492 and marriages 30,049, as against 61,137 births, 40,563 deaths and 29,551 marriages during the corresponding nine months of last year. This comparison shows increases of 4 per cent in births and 2 per cent in marriages, and a decrease of 5 per cent in deaths.
