REGISTRATIONS OF BIRTHS, DEATHS AND MARRIAGES, JANUARY, 1939.

The Dominion Bureau of Statistics issues today the number of registrations of births, deaths and marriages during the month of January, 1939, in 66 cities and towns of Canada having 10,000 population and over.

Births registered in these cities and towns in January numbered 7,088, deaths 4,601 and marriages 2,371 as compared with 6,660 births, 4,601 deaths and 2,413 marriages in January last year, showing an increase of $6\frac{1}{2}$ per cent in births, no change in deaths and a decrease of 2 per cent in marriages.
