REGISTRATIONS OF BIRTHS, DEATHS AND MARRIAGES, OCTOBER, 1939.

The Dominion Bureau of Statistics issues to-day the number of registrations of births, deaths and marriages during the month of October, 1939, in 67 cities and towns of Canada having 10,000 population and over.

Births registered in these cities and towns in October numbered 7,300, deaths 4,228, and marriages 7,297, as compared with 6,819 births, 4,230 deaths and 4,607 marriages in October last year, showing increases of 7 per cent in births and  $58\frac{1}{2}$  per cent in marriages and practically no change in deaths.

Births registered during the ten menths January-October, of this year, totalled 72,913, deaths 43,866 and marriages 41,104 as against 70,450 births, 42,722 deaths and 34,617 marriages during the corresponding ten months of last year. This comparison shows increases of  $3\frac{1}{2}$  per cent in births, 3 per cent in deaths and 19 per cent in marriages.
