REGISTRATIONS OF BIRTHS, DEATHS AND MARRIAGES, NOVEMBER, 1939.

The Dominion Bureau of Statistics issues to-day the number of registrations of births, deaths and marriages during the month of November, 1939, in 67 cities and towns of Canada having 10,000 population and over.

Births registered in these cities and towns in November numbered 6,721, deaths 4,214 and marriages 5,037 as compared with 6,895 births, 4,328 deaths and 3,419 marriages in November last year, showing decreases of 2½ per cent in births and deaths and an increase of 47 per cent in marriages.

Births registered during the eleven months January - November, of this year, totalled 79,634, deaths 48,080 and marriages 46,141 as against 77,345 births, 47,050 deaths and 38,036 marriages during the corresponding eleven months of last year. This comparison shows increases of 3 per cent in births, 2 per cent in deaths and 21 per cent in marriages.
