REGISTRATIONS OF BIRTHS, DEATHS AND MARRIAGES, APRIL, 1939.

The Dominion Bureau of Statistics issues today the number of registrations of births, deaths and marriages during the month of April, 1939, in 67 cities and towns of Canada having 10,000 population and over.

Births registered in these cities and towns in April numbered 7,375, deaths 4,401 and marriages 2,931 as compared with 6,813 births, 4,606 deaths and 2,933 marriages in April last year, showing an increase of eight per cent in births and a decrease of  $4\frac{1}{2}$  per cent in deaths while there was practically no change in marriages.

Births registered during the four months, January - April of this year totalled 28,319, deaths 19,004 and marriages 9,327 as against 27,341 births, 18,181 deaths and 9,646 marriages during the corresponding four months of last year. This comparison shows increases of  $3\frac{1}{2}$  per cent in births,  $4\frac{1}{2}$  per cent in deaths and a decrease of 3 per cent in marriages.
