REGISTRATIONS OF BIRTHS, DEATHS AND MARRIAGES, JUNE, 1939

The Dominion Bureau of Statistics issues today the number of registrations of births, deaths and marriages during the month of June, 1939, in 66 cities and towns of Canada having 10,000 population and over.

Births registered in these cities and towns in June numbered 7,305, deaths 3,976 and marriages 4,782, as compared with 6,984 births, 3,990 deaths and 4,913 marriages in June last year, showing an increase of 4½ per cent in births, practically no change in deaths and a decrease of 2½ per cent in marriages.

Births registered during the six months January-June of this year totalled 43,125, deaths 27,691 and marriages 17,501 as against 41,348 births, 26,766 deaths and 17,743 marriages during the corresponding six months of last year. This comparison shows increases of 4 per cent in births and 3½ per cent in deaths and a decrease of one per cent in marriages.
