REGISTRATIONS OF BIRTHS, DEATHS AND MARRIAGES, JULY: 1939:

The Dominion Bureau of Statistics issues to-day the number of registrations of births, deaths and marriages during the month of July, 1939, in 67 cities and towns of Canada having 10,000 population and over.

Births registered in these cities and towns in July numbered 7,503, deaths 4,094 and marriages 4,373, as compared with 7,283 births, 3,872 deaths and 3,686 marriages in July last year, showing increases of 3 per cent in births, 6 per cent in deaths and 185 per cent in marriages.

Births registered during the seven months, January-July, of this year totalled 50,899, deaths 31,903 and marriages 22,073 as against 48,874 births, 30,770 deaths and 21,634 marriages during the corresponding seven months of last year. This comparison shows increases of 4 per cent in births, 3½ per cent in deaths and 2 per cent in marriages.
