REGISTRATIONS OF BIRTHS, DEATHS AND MARRIAGES, AUGUST,

The Dominion Bureau of Statistics issues to-day the number of registrations of births, deaths and marriages during the month of August, 1939, in 67 cities and towns of Canada having 10,000 population and over-

Births registered in these cities and towns in August numbered 7,217, deaths 3,786 and marriages 3,859, as compared with 7,473 births, 3,686 deaths and 3,625 marriages in August last year, showing a decrease of $3\frac{1}{2}$ per cent in births and increases of 3 per cent in deaths and $6\frac{1}{2}$ per cent in marriages.

Births registered during the eight months, January-August, of this year, totalled 58, 116, deaths 35,689 and marriages 25,805 as against 56,347 births, 34,456 deaths and 25,259 marriages during the corresponding eight months of last year. This comparison shows increases of 3 per cent in births, 32 per cent in deaths and 2 per cent in marriages.
