REGISTRATIONS OF BIRTHS, DEATHS AND MARRIAGES, OCTOBER, 1940.

The Dominion Bureau of Statistics issues today the number of registrations of births, deaths and marriages during the month of October, 1940, in 67 cities and towns of Canada having 10,000 population and over.

Births registered in these cities and towns in October numbered 8,347, deaths 4,721 and marriages 5,412 as compared with 7,300 births, 4,228 deaths and 7,355 marriages in October last year, showing increases of 14 per cent in births, $11\frac{1}{2}$ per cent in deaths, and a decrease of $26\frac{1}{2}$ per cent in marriages.

Births registered during the ten months January - October of this year totalled 80,884, deaths 14,687 and marriages 54,656 as against 72,913 births, 43,866 deaths and 41,442 marriages during the corresponding ten months last year. This comparison shows increases of 11 per cent in births, 2 per cent in deaths and 32 per cent in marriages.
