## REGISTRATIONS OF BIRTHS, DEATHS AND MARRIAGES, FEBRUARY, 1940.

The Dominion Bureau of Statistics issues today the number of registrations of births, deaths and marriages during the month of February, 1940, in 67 cities and towns of Canada having 10,000 population and over.

Births registered in these cities and towns in February numbered 7,007, deaths 4,438 and marriages 3,052, as compared with 6,515 births, 4,570 deaths and 2,314 marriages in February last year, showing increases of 4 per cent in births and  $27\frac{1}{2}$  per cent in marriages and a decrease of 6 per cent in deaths, when adjustment has been made for the number of days in the month,

Births registered during the two months January - February of this year totalled 14,153, deaths 9,266 and marriages 6,599 as against 13,628 births, 9,181 deaths and 4,710 marriages during the corresponding two months last year. This comparison shows no change in births, a decrease of  $2\frac{1}{2}$  per cent in deaths and an increase of 35 per cent in marriages, when adjustment has been made for the number of days in the month of February.
