REGISTRATIONS OF BIRTHS, DEATHS.AND MARRIAGES, MARCH, 1940.

The Dominion Bureau of Statistics issues today the number of registrations of births, deaths and marriages during the month of March, 1940, in 67 cities and towns of Canada having 10,000 population and over.

Births registered in these cities and towns in March numbered 7,944, deaths 4,606 and marriages 3,192, as compared with 7,316 births, 5,422 deaths and 1,686 marriages in March last year, showing increases of $8\frac{1}{2}$ per cent in births and 89 per cent in marriages and a decrease of 15 per cent in deaths.

Births registered during the three months January - March of this year totalled 21,856, deaths. 13,719 and marriages 9,685 as against 20,944 births, 14,603 deaths and 6,396 marriages during the corresponding three months last year. This comparison shows increases of 4 per cent in births and $51\frac{1}{2}$ per cent in marriages and a decrease of 6 per cent in deaths.
