REGISTRATIONS OF BIRTHS, DEATHS AND MARRIAGES, June, 1940.

The Dominion Bureau of Statistics issues today the number of registrations of births, deaths and marriages during the month of June, 1940, in 67 cities and towns of Canada having 10,000 population and over.

Births, registered in these cities and towns in June numbered 8,573, deaths 4,122 and marriages 7,320, as compared with 7,576 births, 4,094 deaths and 4,981 marriages in June last year, showing increases of 13 per cent in births, one-half per cent in deaths and 47 per cent in marriages.

Births registered during the six months January-June of this year totalled 46,109, deaths 27,293 and marriages 25,651 as against 43,396 births, 27,809 deaths and 17,700 marriages during the corresponding six months last year. This comparison shows increases of 6 per cent in births and 45 per cent in marriages and a decrease of 2 per cent in deaths.
