REGISTRATIONS OF BIRTHS, DEATHS AND MARRIAGES, JULY, 1940.

The Dominion Bureau of Statistics issues today the number of registrations of births, deaths and marriages during the month of July, 1940, in 66 cities and towns of Canada having 10,000 population and over.

Births registered in these cities and towns in July numbered 9,002, deaths 4,334 and marriages 10,287 as compared with 7,455 births, 4,074 deaths and 4,385 marriages in July last year, showing increases of 21 per cent in births, 62 per cent in deaths and 1342 per cent in marriages.

Births registered ruring the seven months January - July of this year totalled 55,111, deaths 31,627 and marriages 35,938 as against 50,851 births 31,883 deaths and 22,085 marriages during the corresponding seven months last year. This comparison shows increases of $8\frac{1}{2}$ per cent in births and 63 per cent in marriages and a decrease of one per cent in deaths.
