## REGISTRATIONS OF BIRTHS, DEATHS AND MARRIAGES, SEPTEMBER, 1940.

The Dominion Bureau of Statistics issues today the number of registrations of births, deaths and marriages during the month of September, 1940, in 65 cities and towns of Canada having 10,000 population and over.

Births registered in these cities and towns in September numbered 8,203, deaths 4,165 and marriages 6,126 as compared with 7,409 births, 3,919 deaths and 8,029 marriages in September last year, showing increases of 11 per cent in births, 6 per cent in deaths and a decrease of 24 per cent in marriages.

Births registered during the nine months January - September of this year totalled 72,215, deaths 39,926 and marriages 49,215 as against 65,525 births, 39,608 deaths and 34,051 marriages during the corresponding nine months last year. This comparison shows increases of 10 per cent in births, one per cent in deaths and 442 per cent in marriages.
