REGISTRATIONS OF BIRTHS, DEATHS AND MACRIAGES, JANUARY, 1941.

The Dominion Bureau of Statistics issues today the number of registrations of births, deaths and marriages during the month of January, 1941, in 66 cities and towns of Canada having 10,000 population and over.

Births registered in these cities and towns in January numbered 8,278, deaths 5,473 and marriages 3,313, as compared with 7,110 births, 4,811 deaths and 3,524 marriages in January last year, showing increases of $16\frac{1}{2}$ per cent in births, 14 per cent in deaths and a decrease of 6 per cent in marriages.
