REGISTRATIONS OF BIRTHS, DEATHS AND MARRIAGES, NOVEMBER, 1941.

The Dominion Bureau of Statistics issues today the number of registrations of births, deaths and marriages during the month of November, 1941, in 67 cities and towns of Canada having 10,000 population and over.

Births registered in these cities and towns in November numbered 8,362, deaths 4,253 and marriages 4,955, as compared with 7,857 births, 4,630 deaths and 4,430 marriages in November last year, showing increases of $6\frac{1}{2}$ per cent in births and 12 per cent in marriages, and a decrease of 8 per cent in deaths.

Births registered during the eleven months January-November of this year totalled 97,450, deaths 49,682 and marriages 58,255, as against 88,741 births, 49,317 deaths and 59,086 marriages during the corresponding eleven months last year. This comparison shows increases of 10 per cent in births and one per cent in deaths, and a decrease of $1\frac{1}{2}$ per cent in marriages.
