REGISTRATIONS OF BIRTHS, DEATHS AND MARRIAGES, FEBRUARY, 1941.

The Dominion Bureau of Statistics issues today the number of registrations of births, deaths and marriages during the month of February, 1941, in 67 cities and towns of Canada having 10,000 population and over.

Births registered in these cities and towns in February numbered 7,857, deaths 4,436 and marriages 3,896, as compared with 6,765 births, 4,285 deaths and 2,947 marriages in February last year, showing increases of 16 per cent in births, $3\frac{1}{2}$ per cent in deaths and 32 per cent in marriages.

Births registered during the two months January - February of this year totalled 16,166, deaths 9,929 and marriages 7,234 as against 13,912 births, 19,113 deaths and 6,493 marriages during the corresponding two months last year. This comparison shows increases of 16 per cent in births, 9 per cent in deaths and 112 per cent in marriages.
