REGISTRATIONS OF BIRTHS, DEATHS AND MARRIAGES, MARCH, 1941.

The Dominion Eureau of Statistics issues today the number of registrations of births, deaths and marriages during the month of March, 1941, in 57 cities and towns of Canada having 10,000 population and over.

Births registered in these cities and towns in March numbered 8,662, deaths 4,752 and marriages 3,062 as compared with 7,944 births, 4,606 deaths and 3,192 marriages in March last year, showing increases of 9 per cent in births, 3 per cent in deaths and a decrease of 4 per cent in marriages.

Births registered during the three months January - March of this year totalled 24,828, deaths 14,681 and marriages 10,296 as against 21,856 births, 13,719 deaths and 9,685 marriages during the corresponding three months last year. This comparison shows increases of 13½ per cent in births, 7 per cent in deaths and 6 per cent in marriages.
