REGISTRATIONS OF BIRTHS, DEATHS AND MARRIAGES, MAY, 1941.

The Dominion Bureau of Statistics issues today the number of registrations of births, deaths and marriages during the month of May, 1941, in 67 cities and towns of Canada having 10,000 population and over.

Births registered in these cities and towns in May numbered 9,425, deaths 4,538 and marriages 5,058 as compared with 8,149 births, 4,839 deaths and 4,635 marriages in May last year showing increases of 15½ per cent in births and 9 per cent in marriages and a decrease of 6 per cent in deaths.

Births registered during the five months January - May of this year totalled 43,438, deaths 23,881 and marriages 19,907 as against 37,536 births, 23,171 deaths and 18,331 marriages during the corresponding five months last year. This comparison shows increases of 16 per cent in births, 3 per cent in deaths and 8½ per cent in marriages.
