REGISTRATIONS OF BIRTHS, DEATHS AND MARRIAGES, JULY, 1941.

The Dominion Bureau of Statistics issues today the number of registrations of births, deaths and marriages during the month of July, 1941, in 67 cities and towns of Canada having 10,000 population and over.

Births registered in these cities and towns in July numbered 9,543, deaths 4,330 and marriages 6,110, as compared with 9,066 births, 4,361 deaths and 10,309 marriages in July last year, showing an increase of 5 per cent in births and decreases of one per cent in deaths and 41 per cent in marriages.

Births registered during the seven months January - July of this year totalled 62,215, deaths 32,644 and marriages 33,712 as against 55,175 births, 31,654 deaths and 35,960 marriages during the corresponding seven months last year. This comparison shows increases of 13 per cent in births, 3 per cent in deaths and a decrease of 6 per death in marriages.
