REGISTRATIONS OF BIRTHS, DEATHS AND MARRIAGES, August, 1941.

The Dominion Bureau of Statistics issues today the number of registrations of births, deaths and marriages during the month of August, 1941, in 67 cities and towns of Canada having 10,000 population and over.

Births registered in these cities and towns in August numbered 9,195, deaths 4,228 and marriages 6,322, as compared with 8,837 births, 4,107 deaths and 7,129 marriages in August last year, showing increases of 4 per cent in births and 3 per cent in deaths and a decrease of 11 per cent in marriages.

Births registered during the eight months January - August of this year totalled 71,410, deaths 36,872 and marriages 40,034 as against 64,012 births, 35,761 deaths and 43,089 marriages during the corresponding eight months last year. This comparison shows increases of $11\frac{1}{2}$ per cent in births and 3 per cent in deaths and a decrease of 7 per cent in marriages.
