REGISTRATIONS OF BIRTHS, DEATHS AND MARRIAGES, SEPTEMBER, 1941.

The Dominion Bureau of Statistics issues today the number of registrations of births, deaths and marriages during the month of September, 1941, in 67 cities and towns of Canada having 10,000 population and over.

Births registered in these cities and towns in September numbered 8,746, deaths 4,157 and marriages 7,166, as compared with 8,525 births, 4,205 deaths and 6,155 marriages in September last year, showing increases of 2 1/2 per cent in births and 16 1/2 per cent in marriages, and a decrease of one per cent in deaths.

Births registered during the nine months January - September of this year totalled 80,156, deaths 41,029, and marriages 47,200, as against 72,537 births, 39,966 deaths and 49,244 marriages during the corresponding nine months last year. This comparison shows increases of 10 1/2 per cent in births and 2 1/2 per cent in deaths, and a decrease of 4 per cent in marriages.
