## DIVORCES IN CANADA, 1940.

There were 2,369 divorcos grantod in Canada in the calendar year 1940 , 2,307 being granted by the courts of soven provincos, whilo 62 were granted by the Dominion Parliamont, to potitionors whosc logal domicilo was in tho Province of Quobec.

Through tho courtesy of the various Provincial authoritios concernod with the registration of divorco docrees, a revision of the statistics of divorces granted appears in this bullotin. Tho figures that havo beon changod are markod in Tablos 1 and 2; as now prosontcd, thoy show the numbers of decrees absolute grantod, figuros of annulments having been eliminated whero possible. For those provinces where it was not possiblo to make such elimination, annulments make up a negligible proportion of the total.

As compared with the rovisod figures for 1939, divorces increased by 301 , or 14.6 per cent. Ontario and British Columbia, with 169 and 93, respectively, accounted for the groator part of the increase. The other provincos recorded lobser increasos, except Nova Scotia, Saskatchewan and Prince Bdward Island. There were no divorces grantod in the lattor Province.

The Sex of Applicants for Divorcos.- Up till 1924, Canada's divorce statistics differod from those of most other countrios in that they showod that a majority of the divorces grantod wore on the petition of the husband. In 1924 wives obtained 51.2 per cent of the decrees eranted, but in 1925 husbands wero gain in the majority of successful petitioners with 50.6 per cent. From 1926 to 1933 wives received betwoen 50 and 60 per cent of the divorces granted. From 1934 the proportion increased; in 1940 it was 63.2 por cent. In New Zealand wives received betweon 50 and 60 per cent of the divorces grantod bom twoon 1928 and 1938. Whilo in the Unitod States thoy receivod from 70.5 to 73.5 per cent of the petitions grantod in the yoars 1927 to 1932.

Proportion of Divorcod Porsons in the population.- At the 1931 Census. there wore onumeratod 4,049 divorced malos and 3.392 divorcod fomalos in the Dominion, or 0.08 per cont and 0.07 por cont of oach sex, respectively, while in 1921 the figures recorded wore 3.670 and 3.731 or 0.08 per cent and 0.09 per cent, respoctively. As among the nine provincos, British Columbia showed the highest percentage of divorced persons in the population with 0.24 of each sex, While Quebec showod the lowest percentago with 0.02 males and 0.03 females. Divorced persons who have subsequently been romarried are, of course, recorded in the coneus as married.

Remarriage of Divorced Persons, - in interesting side-light on the divorce question is afforded $3 y$ tho figures of divorced porsons who remarriod In the yoars 1926 to 1939, as shown in Table 3. The statistics indicated that the number of divorced persons remarrying is increasing pari passu with the number of divorces. Table 4 shows by provinces tho number of divorcod persons who remarriod in the five yoars 1935 to 1939.

## CO:APARISONS WITH OTHER COUNTRIES

In Table 5 are given comparative figures of divorces and marriages in Ingland and Wales, Australia, New Zealand and Canada for the years 1916 and subsequently. The percentage of divorces to marriages taking place in the same year, as here given, is seen in the case of England and Wales to have increased during these years from 0.35 per cent to 1.73 per cent; in dustralia from 1.53 per cont to 4.64 per cent; in New Zealand from 2.41 per cent to 6.85 per cent; and in Canada from 0.1 per cent to 2.01 per cent. Similar figures for the United States, whore, of course, the total number of divorces is unusually large cwing to the comparative oase with which thoy may be obtained, show increases from 27,919 in 1887 to 42,937 in 1896, 72,062 in 1906, 114,000 in 1916, 148,815 in 1922, 165,096 in 1923, 170,952 in 1924, 175 , 449 in 1925, 180,853 in 1926, 192,037 in 1927, 195.939 in 1928, 201,468 in 1929, falling to 191,591 in 1930, 183,664 in 1931 and 160,338 in 1932. The percentage of djvorces to marriages increased from 10.6 to 16.3 during the years 1916 to 1932, divorces during this period increasing by 40.64 per cent. No statistics of divorces granted in the United States have been published since those for 1932 , but estimatos would indicate that there were some 165,000 divorces granted in 1933, 204, 000 in 1934, 218,000 in 1935, 236,000 in 1936 and 250,000 in 1937. The estimated percentages of divorcos to marriages were 15.0 per cent, 15.7 per cent, 16.4 per cent, 17.2 per cent and 17.5 per cent in the same years. The number of divorces per 1,000 of population was 1.8 in 1936 and 1.9 in 1937.
