JUVENILE STATISTICS, 1935

INTRODUCTION

The returns of Juvenile Statistics for 1935 show a slight decrease (.54 p.c.) in the numbers of cases brought before the Courts as compared with 1934. Increases are shown in Prince Edward Island, New Brunswick, Quebec, Ontario and Saskatchewan with decreases shown in Nova Scotia, Manitoba, Alberta and British Columbia.

Major delinquencies show an increase of 3.8 per cent with a decrease of 12 p.c. shown in conviction for minor delinquencies.

The above figures show that the proportion of repeaters has not varied materially during the ten years, that approximately one of every four delinquents has been in court before, that one in nine has had one previous conviction, and that one in six has had more than one previous conviction.

Out of 5,514 Juvenile Delinquents convicted of Major Offences, 5,298 were born in Canada and 216 in other countries. Of Canadian born delinquents 3,582 had both parents born in Canada, while 321 had one parent born in Canada. All other had both parents born in other countries.

STATISTIQUE DE LA CRIMINALITÉ JUVÉNILE, 1935

INTRODUCTION

Les statistiques des jeunes délinquants montrent une légère baisse en 1935 (-54 p.c.) dans le nombre de cas cités devant les tribunaux comparativement à 1934. Il y a des augmentations dans l'Ile du Prince-Edouard, le Nouveau-Brunswick, le Québec, l'Ontario et la Saskatchewan, et des diminutions en Nouvelle-Ecosse, dans le Manitoba, dans l'Alberta et dans la Colombie Britannique.

Les délits majeurs montrent une augmentation de 3·8 p.c. et les offenses mineures, une diminution de 12 p.c. dans les condamnations.
