



Introduction

This report is based upon data collected via the Police Administration Statistics Annual Survey conducted by the Canadian Centre for Justice Statistics. This survey is the primary mechanism for the collection of national statistics for municipal, provincial and federal police forces.

In order to provide data suppliers with some results of the annual survey, the Policing Services Program has been circulating to the policing community a yearly report based upon the characteristics of individual municipal police departments across the country. Due to the nature of these data, and their inherent limitations, the information is intended strictly as an indicator of the personnel strength and expenditures (see "Notes" for further clarification).

Notes

- Data on police personnel refer to "actual" strength count of personnel. "Actual" strength means the number of permanent full-time as well as permanent part-time employees who were on the personnel roster as of September 30 of each year.
- Population figures appearing in this report are based upon those reported by provincial "focal points", in addition to population policed estimates as agreed to by the jurisdictions Population data are regularly updated and as such, rates published in the report may differ slightly from rates published in other separate reports.
- A major concern regarding data from the police administration survey pertains to the scope of the expenditure data and precisely what can be considered comparable between forces, the provinces and the three levels of policing. It is important to note that any comparisons should be done with caution as only those expenditures paid for out of a police department's budget are reflected in this report. As an example, for some forces and not others, accommodation costs or costs associated with by-law enforcement and court security are paid for by the municipality rather than the police department. Similarly, RCMP municipal contract expenditures do not include the cost of municipal employees provided at no charge to the RCMP by the municipality.

- The population per police officer ratios for the OPP should be seen as approximate. In a number of cases the OPP deal with a transient population (cottagers, parks and beaches) which compounds the work of the force without increasing the population. This is particularly true during the summer months when summer populations considerably increase the yearly populations of some municipalities. Furthermore, the OPP's traffic detachments patrol a large number of busy highways for which no population is assigned. For these reasons population is difficult to measure.
- Criminal Code data were taken from the Uniform Crime Reporting Program, Canadian Centre for Justice Statistics.
- In the case of RCMP municipal contract forces, under the current cost sharing agreement, in 1992/93 costs were shared 70% municipal and 30% federal for municipalities under 15,000 population. For municipalities of 15,000 population and over, costs were shared 90% municipal and 10% federal. Contract costs do not include municipal employees provided at no cost to the RCMP by the municipality.
